Dear Board of Directors and Operations Team,

Happy May! As spring arrives in the northern part of the U.S., new life continues to emerge within our organization and our profession. As you know, this internal newsletter serves to keep Board and Operations Team members updated about important activities within ISMETA and our field. As usual, there is a lot of information to share!

NEW ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- The Executive Committee and the Professional Development Center (PDC) Workgroup are delighted to offer members of the Board of Directors and the Operations Team a 50% discount on events in the Professional Development Center, as space is available. For courses without registration limits (e.g., Jim Spira's workshop on March 23, 2024), members of the Board and the Operations Team can register any time before the published registration deadline. For courses with a registration limit, available space is determined the day after the registration deadline, which is usually five days before the start of the event for shorter workshops and up to two weeks before longer class series. If you are interested in signing up for an event with a registration limit, please contact Elisabeth or Rich on the day after the registration deadline to see if space is available.
- Upcoming events include:
 - Susan Bauer's May 18 workshop, "The Embodied Teen: Teaching Somatic Movement Practices to Teens and Young Adults," which has a registration limit of 35 people. There are currently 16 registered so it is likely (but not guaranteed) that there will be space for members of the Board/ Operations Team to attend at a 50% discount. (The full price for ISMETA members is \$75). We will know if there is space available on May 15.
 - Robert Litman's 3-class series, "<u>The Breathable Body: A Somatic Movement Approach to Breathing</u>," which runs on June 1, June 15 and June 29 from 10am 12 pm ET, has a registration limit of 25 people. Registration has just begun. We will know if there is space available for Board/Operations Team members on May 28th.
- Bibiana Badenes will discuss (in English and Spanish) her new book, Body Intelligence:
 Discover the Power of Conscious Movement, on Friday, June 7 from 12 1 pm Eastern time!

- Rich, Elisabeth, and Nirvan completed the Annual Report for 2023. It appears <u>HERE</u> in the Member portal.
- An applicant who submitted a proposal for an entirely asynchronous online training program asked if ISMETA has guidelines for Approved Training Programs about the percentage of training hours that must be synchronous online and in person. In response, the Professional Standards Committee asked the Leadership Council for input about the role of online learning currently in their programs/associations and in the future. HERE is a PowerPoint presentation that Elisabeth Osgood-Campbell delivered at the last Leadership Council meeting on March 14, 2024. There was an issue with one part of the audio recording that we are fixing, but you can view the rest of the video; it clears within a few minutes.
- Financial Update: year-to-date 3rd quarter numbers for this fiscal year (2024) from the Profit and Loss Statement:

Registered Member Dues $^{\sim}$ \$ 135,818 (up 6.5% from last year) Total Income $^{\sim}$ \$ 173,652 (up 29.9% from last year) Total Expenses $^{\sim}$ \$ 166,208 (up 7.4% from last year) Net Income $^{\sim}$ \$ 7,443 (up 133.9% from last year)

Note: Professional Development Center revenue and expenses are the primary causes of our increase in Income, Expenses and Net Income versus last year. Mentorship revenue also contributes to the increase in Total Income and Net Income.

From Balance Sheet:

- Total Assets are \$41,400 (down \$12,594 from last year)
- Total Liabilities and Equity are \$41,401 (\$20,397 are liabilities consisting of payments received for multi-year memberships; \$21,004 is our Total Equity).
